| 5. Rust flowers on khaki ground F467 col.2 | - | fat ¼ |
| 6. Delicate floral with lines on cream F471 col.2 | - | fat ¼ |
| 7. Fans with khaki ground F466 col.1 | - | 80cm (7/8yard) |
| 8. Buttermilk from Perfect Palette H50 col.33 | - | 70cm (3/4yard) |
| 9. Parchment from Perfect Palette H50 col.20 | - | 1m (1yard) |

Wadding and backing 52" x 52" (Warm and Natural)

Thread Auri fil

4656 brown/cream

Template plastic

Cutting

Template On a piece of paper draw an oblong 3 1/8" x 4 1/2" using a black pencil. Measure and mark, 3/4" in from each side, on the bottom edge. From these marks draw a line to the top right and top left corners. Draw a very gentle upward curve along the bottom line. Trace onto template plastic and cut out. All seam allowances are included on the template.

From fabric 1 cut

25 x 3¾" x 3¾" squares.

From fabric 2 cut

16 from the template

From fabric 3 cut

16 from the template

From fabric 4 cut
16 from the template
From fabric 5 cut
16 from the template
From fabric 6 cut
16 from the template
From fabric 7 cut
45 x $2\frac{5}{8}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strips (sashing)
From fabric 8 cut
90 x 1" x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strips (sashing)
From fabric 9 cut
16 x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

To make the block

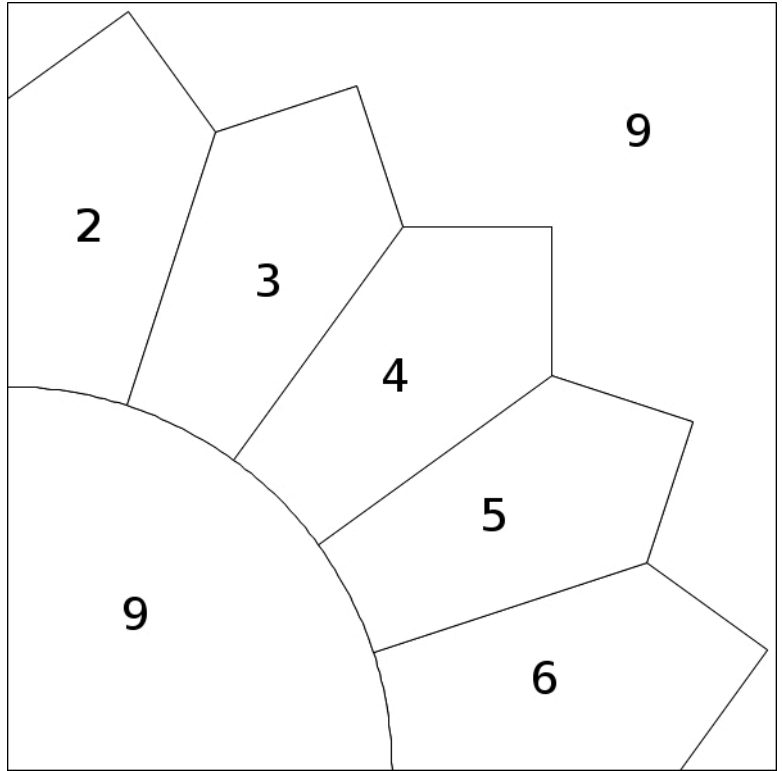
- First make the fan pieces, fold each piece in half lengthways and stitch across the wider end. Clip the corners and turn to right side, fold the top down to make a triangular shaped 'hood' and press. You will need five fan pieces for each block.
- Sew the five fan pieces together as shown in the block diagram.
- Turn under the inner curve of the fan, press, clip and applique to the $8\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat for each block.

Sashing Strips

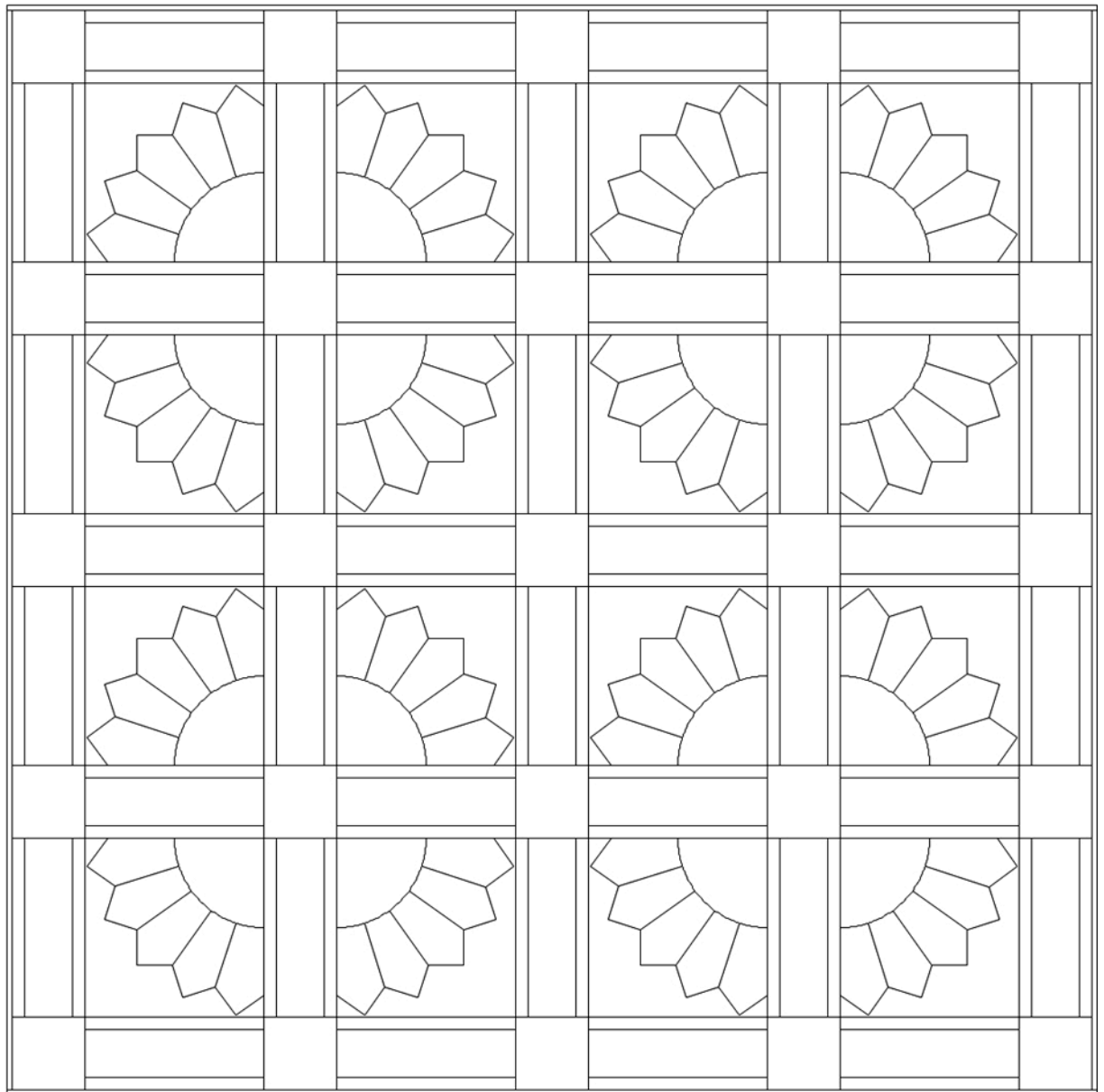
- Take the narrow sashing strips (fabric 8) and sew to either side of the wider sashing strips (fabric 7), press.

Assembling the quilt

- Lay out all the pieces as shown in the main diagram including the small panel squares.
- Sew in rows working from left to right, press as you go.
- Sew the rows together working from top to bottom, press as you go
- Sandwich together the quilt top, wadding and backing fabric and quilt by hand or machine. Echoing the fan shape.
- Add the binding using fabric 8
