

# Celtic Christmas

Designed and Made by Sally Ablett  
Table cloth, 31" across.

## **Requirements**

1. Hexagonals on antique cream ground 284 col. 2 - 2 rows.
2. Gold swirls on red ground 283 col. 1 - 20cm.
3. Gold swirls on green ground 283 col. 4 - 20cm.
4. Gold swirls on antique cream ground 283 col. 3 - 20cm.

Wadding + Backing 35" x 35"

Template Plastic

Gold thread

## **Cutting**

1. 6 from template
2. 1 x 5<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 42"
3. 1 x 5<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 42"

## **Making**

Start by cutting a hexagon from your template plastic with the sides measuring 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>", this includes the seam allowance.

From each of the fabric strips cut 9 equilateral triangles.

Lay out the pieces as in the main diagram.

Start by sewing the 6 triangle pieces in the centre together to form a hexagon.

Split the pieces into 3 horizontal rows.

Assemble these rows working diagonally, by joining the triangles onto the hexagons and then joining these larger pieces together to complete each row.

Once all three rows have been made up, join them together to complete the top layer.

Sandwich together, top layer, wadding and backing and quilt with festive designs using gold thread.

Add binding made from fabric 4.
