4. Anemones F325 col.2 - Fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. Daisies F323 col.2 - 30 cm

6. H50 col.26 opal - Long $\frac{1}{4}$
7. H50 col.31 pistachio - 30cm.
8. H50 col.16 water - 80cm. (border sashing & binding)

Wadding and Backing 40" x 40"

Thread

Aurifil Mako 40

2710 - Pale Blue

2843 - Pale Sage Green

2720 - Mid-Blue

Cutting

1. 5 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
16 x 2" x 2" squares
8 x 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
2. 10 x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares cut in half diagonally twice
4 x 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
3. 5 x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares cut in half diagonally twice
20 x 2" x 2" squares
8 x 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
4. 4 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
8 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares cut in half diagonally once
8 x 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
5. 8 x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares cut in half diagonally twice
8 x 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
8 x 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
6. 5 x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares cut in half diagonally twice
20 x 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
20 x 2" x 2" squares

7. 8 x 4¼" x 4¼" squares cut in half diagonally twice
16 x 2⅜" x 2⅜" squares cut in half diagonally once

8. 12 x 1½" x 42" strips
4 x 3" x 3" squares

Making

Block 1.

Lay out all of the fabric pieces as shown in *diagram 1*.

Start by sewing the small squares of fabric 6 to the small squares of fabric 3, press back and then join this to the oblong of fabric 6 to form a square.

Next join the triangles of fabric 2 to fabric 3 and press back. Join the triangles of fabric 2 to fabric 6 and press back and then join the two larger triangles you've just made together to form a square. You should now have 9 pieces ready to join together to form the block. Join the pieces together in rows and then join the rows together. You will need to make 5 of these in total.

Block 2.

Lay out all of the fabric pieces as shown in diagram 2.

Start by joining the small triangles of fabric 7 to the square of fabric 1 to form a larger triangle, next join this to the triangle of fabric 4 to form a square.

Join together a triangle of 5 and 7 to make a larger triangle, repeat this and join the two triangles together to make a square.

Once you have made up all of the internal pieces of the block, sew them together in rows and then join the rows together to complete the block.

There are 4 of this block in total

Lay out the completed blocks as in the main diagram.

Sew the blocks together in rows, remembering to add a strip of sashing between each block. Then sew the rows together with a strip of sashing between each row.

Add a border strip to the top and bottom edge, followed by the left and right hand side of the quilt.

You now need to make the outer border with fabric 8 using the 2" x 3½" and 1½" x 2" rectangular pieces sewn together in the following order;

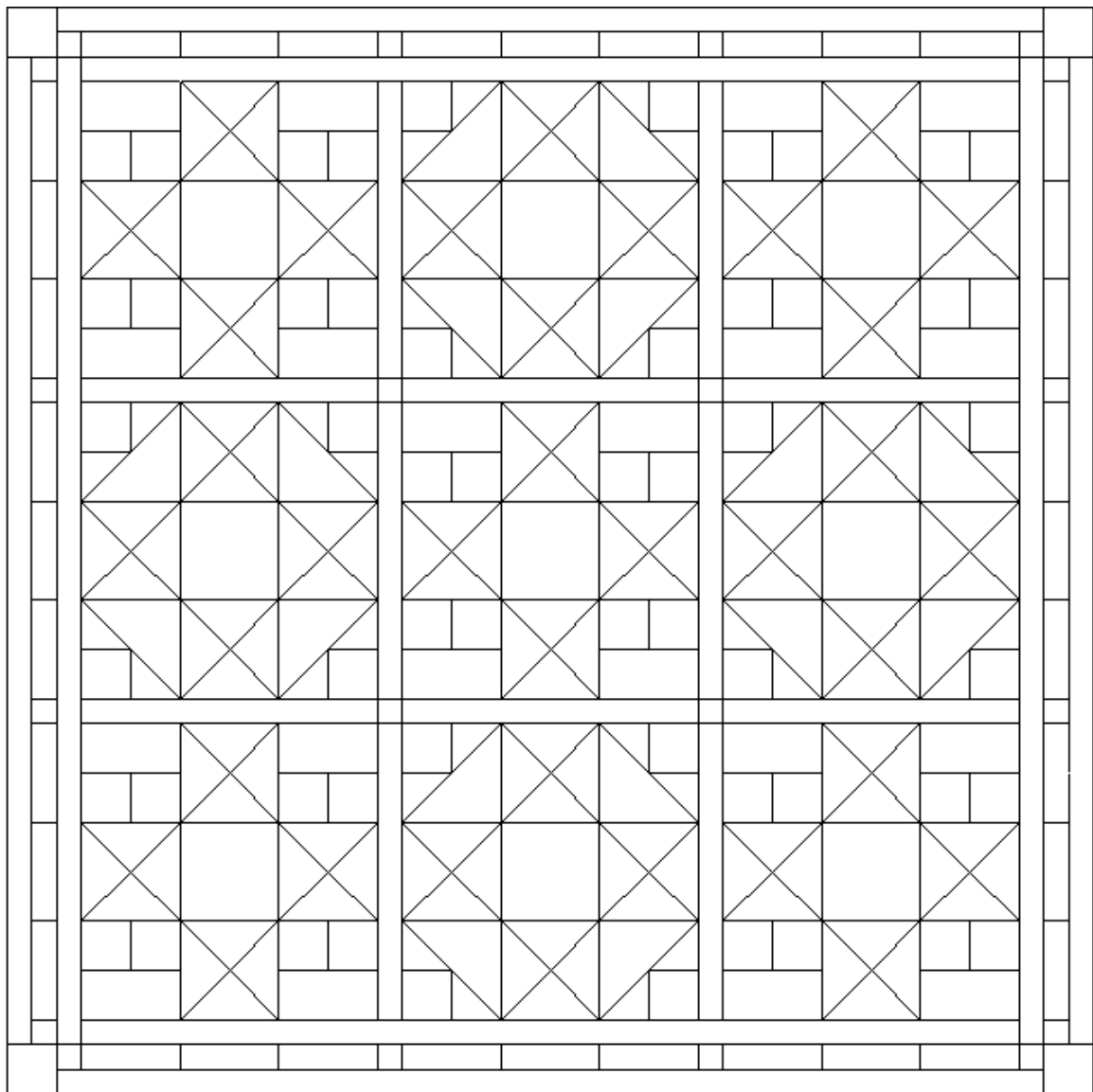
8, 4, 3, 5, 8, 1, 2, 1, 8, 5, 3, 4, 8.

Once you have sewn these together, add a strip of fabric 8 along one edge. Make 4 of these in total.

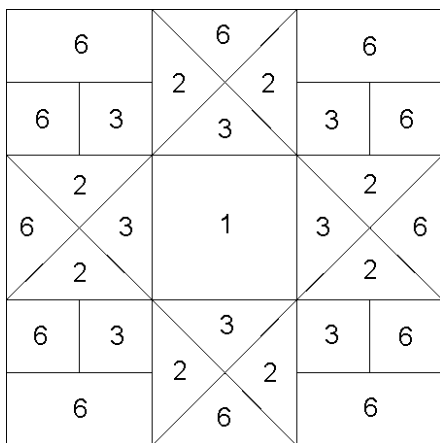
Add the outer border to the top and bottom. With the remaining two border pieces add a 3" x 3" square to both ends. Then add these border strips to the left and right hand side of the quilt to complete the top layer.

Sandwich together the top layer, wadding and backing.

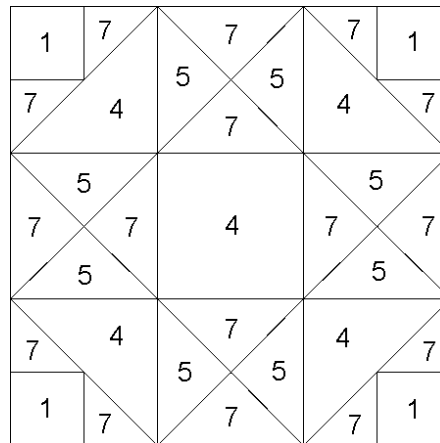
Add binding made from fabric 8 and quilt in the ditch. You may wish to add some further quilting designs in the border.
