| 10. Reflections F1222. col 38 Pale Yellow    | - Fat Qtr      |
| 11. Reflections F1222 col 39 Deep Yellow     | - ¾ yd/ 40cm   |

Backing 53" x 53" Wadding 53" x 53"

### Cutting

**Template** - please refer to diagram 1

Cut a rectangle 6"x 3"

From the top left corner measure in 1⅜" and mark,

Measure down the left side 1⅜" and mark,

Cut between the two marks at an angle of 45°.

From bottom right corner measure up 3" and mark

Cut from this mark to the bottom left corner at an angle of 45°.

## **Block 1**

See diagram

Fabric 2 cut - 11 x  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, cut in half diagonally once - A

Fabric 3 cut - 11 x Template - C

Fabric 4 cut - 11 x 4" x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " - G

Fabric 5 cut - 11 x 4" x 6" - E

Fabric 6 cut - 11 x 3" x  $7\frac{3}{8}$ " cut 45° angle as shown – H

Fabric 7 cut - 11 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{8}$ " cut 45° angle as shown - J

Fabric 9 cut - 11 x 1" x  $7\frac{7}{8}$ ", trim angle to fit - B

11 x 1" x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " - D

11 x 1" x 4", trim angle to fit - F

11 x 1" x  $9\frac{5}{8}$ ", trim angle to fit - I

11 x 1" x  $4\frac{1}{4}$ ", trim angles to fit –K

## **Block 2**

See diagram

For each block cut the following pieces:-

Fabric 1 cut - 5 x scenic squares 8" x 8"

Fabric 10 cut - 10 x 2" x 8"  
10 x 2" x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ "

## **Sashing**

Fabric 9 cut - 24 x 1" x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ "

Fabric 11 cut - 9 x 1" x 1"  
2 x 1" x 42"  
2 x 1" x 43"  
2 x 1" x  $48\frac{1}{2}$ "  
2 x 1" x  $49\frac{1}{2}$ "

## **Border**

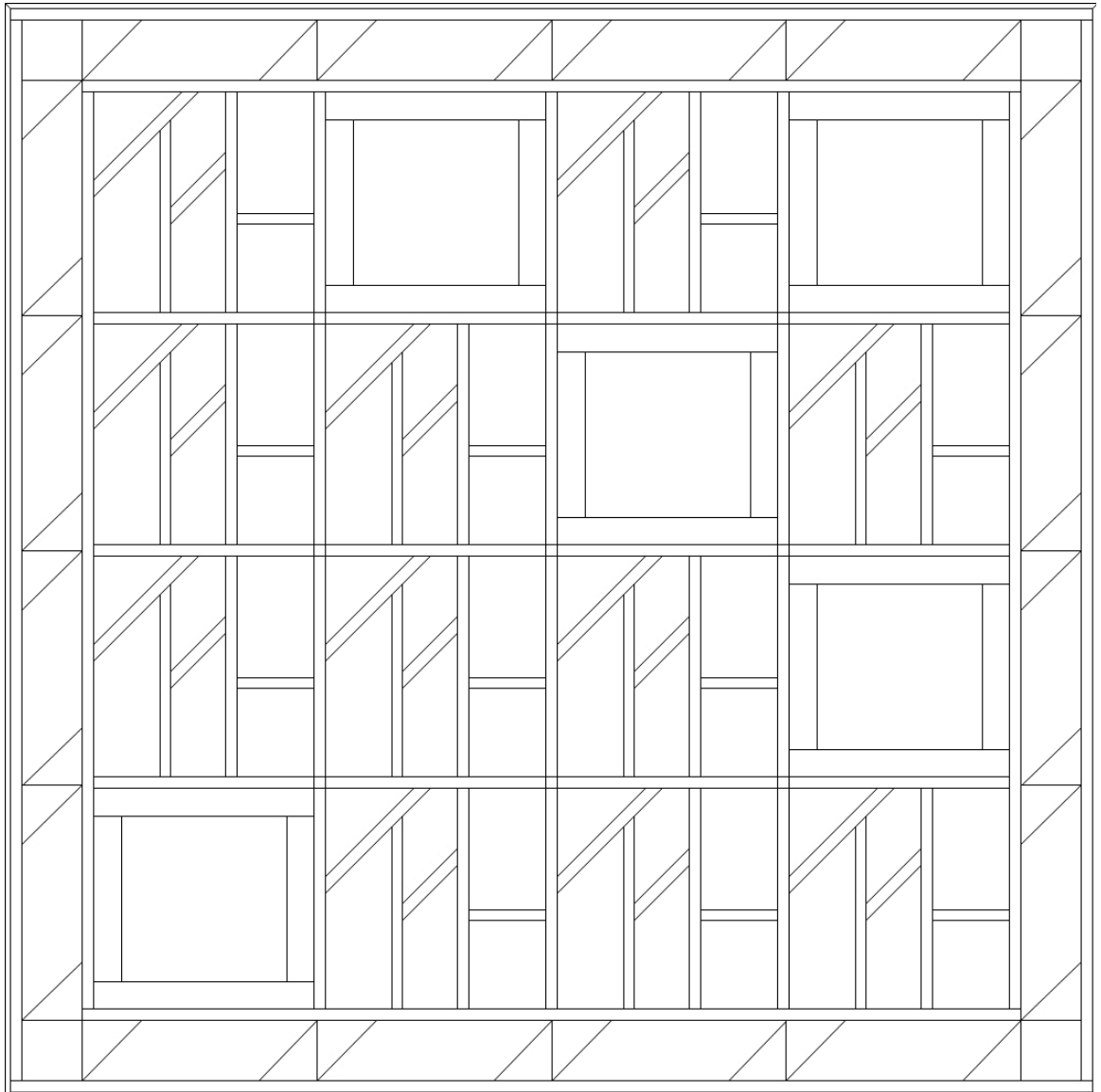
Fabric 8 cut - 16 x  $8\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

Fabric 9 cut - 20 x 3½" x 3½"

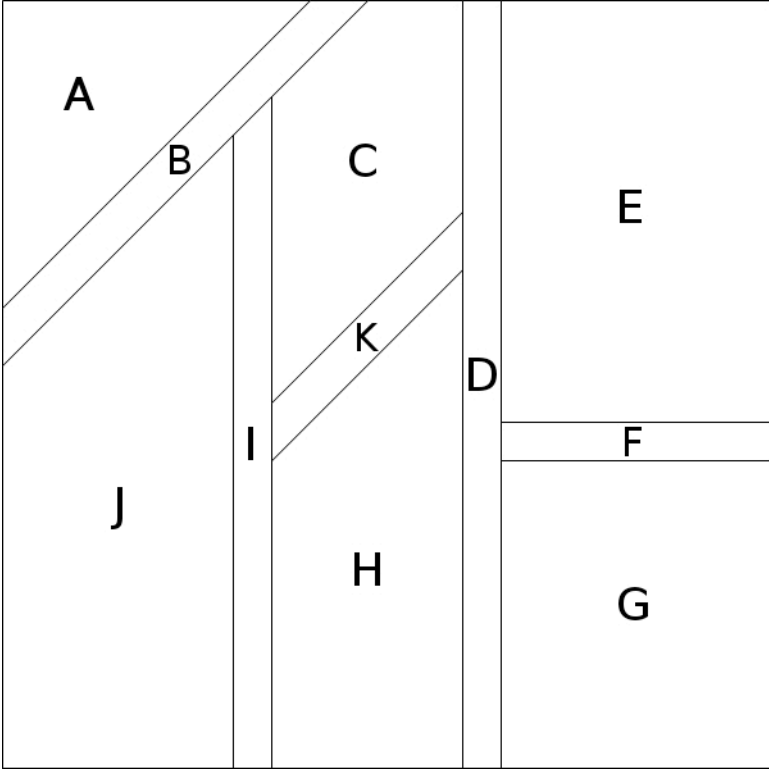
## Stitching

¼" seam allowances are included in all measurements.  
Please press each seam as you sew.

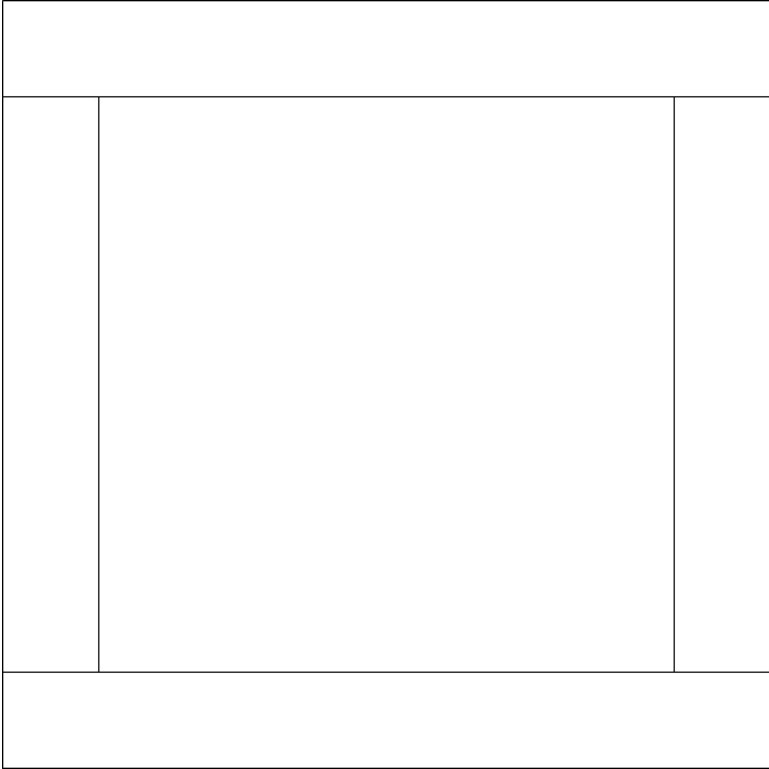
1. Lay out all the fabrics for block 1.
2. Work from right to left sewing the sections in the following sequence.  
E → F → G  
D  
C → K → H  
I  
J  
B  
A
3. Make eleven blocks in total.
4. Next make the picture panels, sew the side strips to the panel first and then the top and bottom strips.
5. Once all the blocks are complete sew them together using the black sashing strips and the yellow squares.
6. Measure the quilt and cut narrow black strips to make the inner border, sew all round.
7. Middle border - place a black square over each end of a 8¾" x 3½" piece right sides together and sew diagonally across the square from bottom left to top right. Press back and trim, make eight in total. Sew together in strips, these will be the top and bottom borders.
8. To make the side border strips use the same technique but sew diagonally across from bottom right to top left. Make eight in total and again sew together into strips.
9. Sew the corner squares to each end of the top and bottom middle border strips.
10. Add the borders to the quilt, sides first and then the top and bottom.
11. Measure the quilt again and cut the yellow outer border strips to fit, sew in place.
12. Layer together the quilt top, wadding and backing fabric and quilt.
13. Add the black binding.



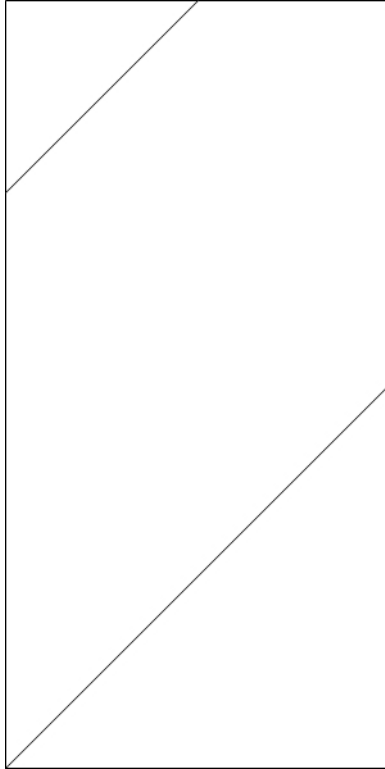
