



Jelly Roll Quilt
Made By Sally Ablett.
Size 48" x 64".
block size 8" x 8".

Jelly rolls created by Fabric Freedom

Requirements.

1 Fj-9004 Multi Jelly Roll.
Wadding and backing 52" x 68"
Thread Aurifil Mako 3770 reat blue.

Cutting.

Take 48 of your fabric strips and cut from each strip.
4 x 2½" x 4½" strips
2 x 2½" x 8½" strips

For each block you will use:-

The outer part of the block, using the same colour
2 x 2½" x 4½" strips
2 x 2½" x 8½" strips

The centre part of each block, using mixed colours
2 x 2½" x 4½" strips

For each block you will have three colours.

Making up.

Sew two assorted colours together from your fabric strips 2½" x 4½", this is for the centre, press as you go.

Next add your outer strips, 2½" x 4½", to the top and bottom, press.

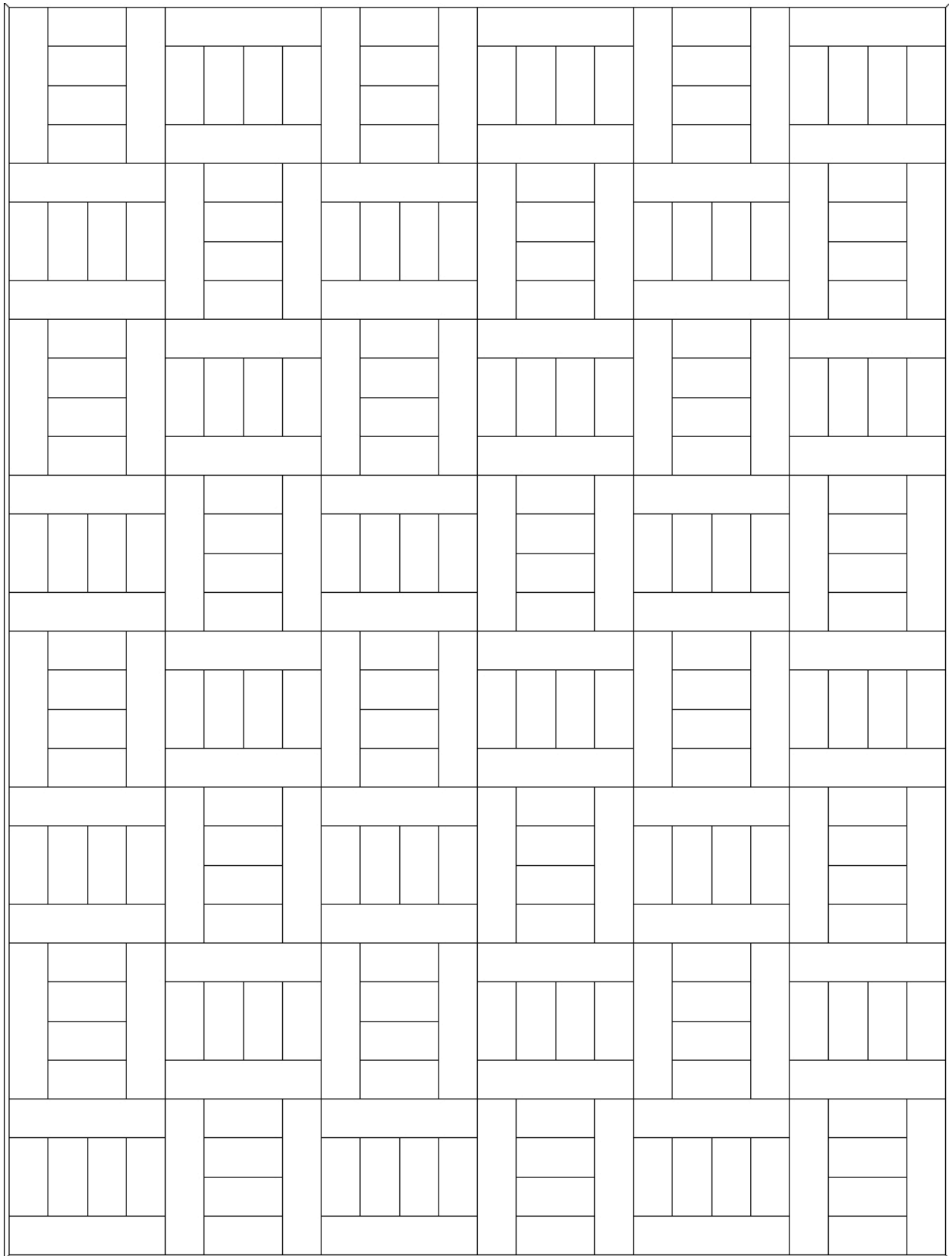
Now add the two side strips, 4 x 2½" x 4½", press.
Make 48 blocks in total.

Sew your completed blocks together in rows of 6, press as you go. You will end up with 8 rows.
Sew the rows together to complete the top layer of the quilt.

Sandwich the top layer, wadding and backing.

Quilt by hand or by sewing machine.

Make binding using the remaining fabric pieces, and add this to the quilt to complete
