Quilt size - 44" x 44"
Blocks size - 10" x 10"
Designed and Made by Sally Ablett

Requirements

1. Chintz floral on black ground F257 col.46 – 70cm.
2. Small daisy on grey ground F261 col.45 – Long $\frac{1}{4}$.
3. Grey chintz on white ground F257-45 – Long $\frac{1}{4}$.
4. Black and grey Persian F259 col.47 – Long $\frac{1}{4}$.
5. Small grey rose F256 col.46 – 50cm.
6. Dark grey Provence Toile F258 col.49 – 30cm.
7. Provence Toile on white F258 col.47 – 30cm.
8. Black and grey graded stripe F263 col.45 – 50cm (Border and Binding)

Wadding and Backing – 48" x 48"

Thread

- 2710 – Light Blue.
- 4665 – Black to green.
- 2692 – Black.

Cutting

Block 1

1. 48 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares – cut in half diagonally once
8 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
4 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x 44" strips
2. 16 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
4 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares – cut in half diagonally twice
3. 16 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
4 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares – cut in half diagonally twice
4. 16 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
4 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares – cut in half diagonally twice

Block 2

5. 52 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
6. 52 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
7. 52 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

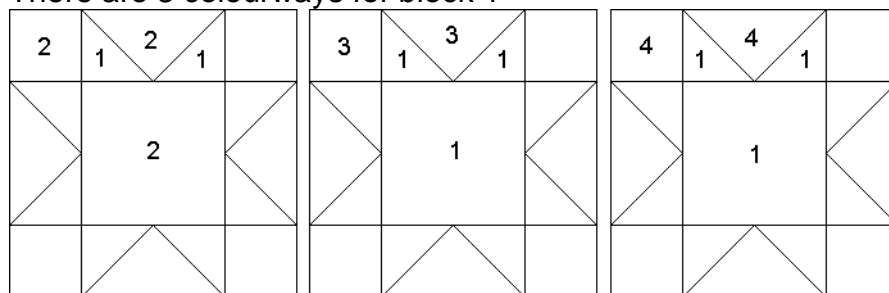
Border

8. 4 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44" strips

Making

Block 1.

There are 3 colourways for block 1



Lay out all of your fabric pieces as shown in the diagram, you should have 4 of each colourway.

Start by sewing the small triangles of fabric 1 to the adjacent larger triangles, pressing back as you go.

Now join all of the block pieces together, first of all in rows and then join the rows together to complete the block.

Block 2.

Lay out the fabric pieces as shown in the diagram.

Start by joining the middle squares of fabric 6 and 7 in rows and then join the rows together to form a larger square.

Now join all of the pieces from block 2 together in rows and then join the rows together to complete the block, there will be 13 in total.

Once all of your blocks have been made, lay them out as shown in the picture.

Join the blocks together in rows and then join the rows together.

Now add the border.

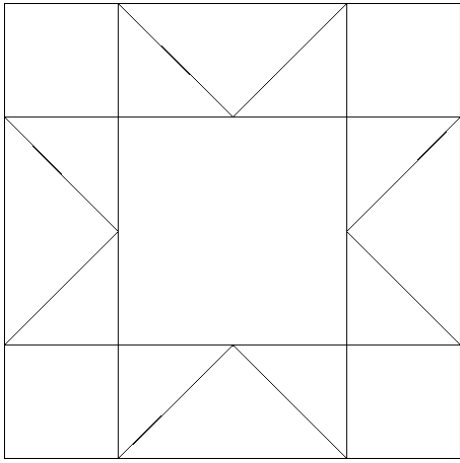
Start with the right hand side of the quilt. Line up the right hand border with the top edge of the quilt and stitch down the border, stopping approximately 2 inches from the bottom of the quilt (you will finish this edge later). Now add the top border. Sew along the entire length of this border piece. Trim the fabric level with the left hand edge of the quilt. Now add the left hand and bottom border strips in the same manner. Once you have added the bottom border, finish sewing the right hand border.

This completes the top layer of the quilt.

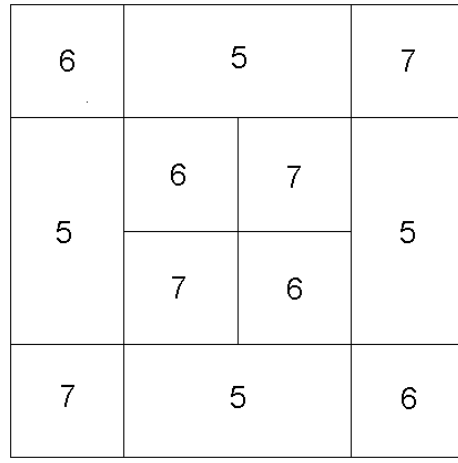
Sandwich together the top layer, wadding and backing.

Quilt in the ditch and with designs of your choice.

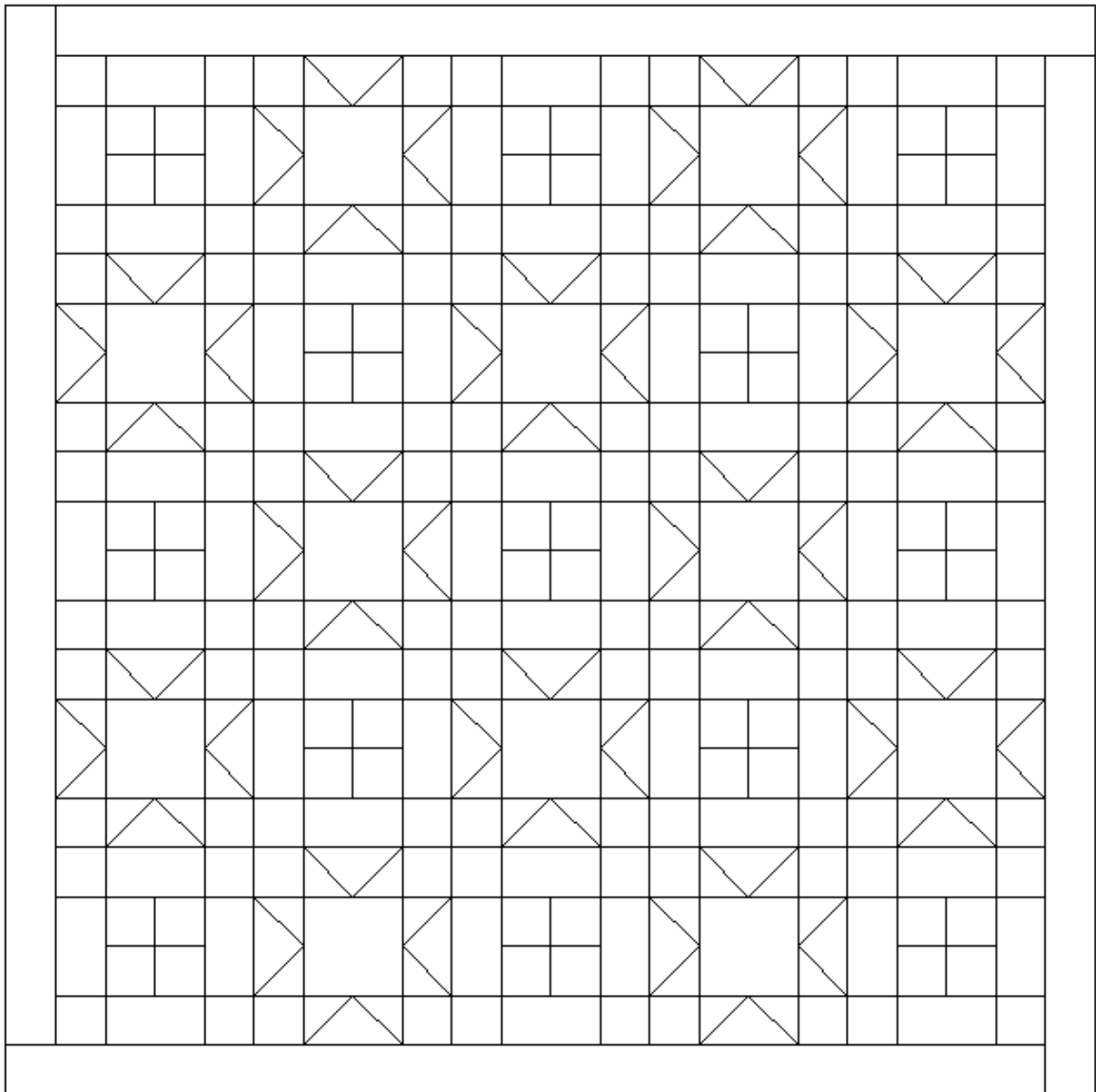
Use fabric 8 to make binding and add this to the quilt to complete.
