Requirements

You will need 20cm. of each of the following.

1. Dark blue chintz rose - F257 col.42
 2. Blue Provence Toile on cream - F258 col.40
 3. Dark blue close daisy - F261 col.41
 4. Small blue Persian floral - F259 col.43
 5. Light blue Provence Toile - F258 col.41
 6. Small light blue rose - F256 col.40
 7. Light blue close daisy - F261 col.44
 8. Blue chintz rose on cream - F257 col.44
 9. Small yellow Persian floral - F259 col.51
 10. Yellow chintz rose - F257 col.50
 11. Yellow close daisy - F261 col.50
 12. Small yellow rose - F256 col.54

13. Yellow graded stripe F263 col.50 - 50cm. (Binding)
 14. Blue graded stripe F263 col.42 - 30cm.

Wadding and Backing 49" x 56"

Thread

Aurifil Mako

2110 Lemon

2715 Pale blue

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut;

51 x 2¼" x 2¼" squares

From fabric 2 cut;

50 x 2¼" x 2¼" squares

From fabric 3 to 12 cut;

52 x 2¼" x 2¼" squares

From fabric 13 cut;

2 x 2½" x 19¾" strips

2 x 2½" x 26¾" strips

4 x 2⅞" x 2⅞" squares, cut in half diagonally once.

From fabric 14, cut;

4 x 2½" x 9¾" strips

4 x 2½" x 11¼" strips

4 x 2⅞" x 2⅞" squares

Making up

Once you have cut out all of your pieces, lay them out as in the diagrams below.

Make up each of the blocks by sewing the fabric pieces together in rows, pressing back each time and then joining the rows together to complete the block.

Once all of the blocks have been made join the blocks together in rows, pressing back each time and now join the rows together in order. This completes the centre panel of the quilt

Take your yellow and blue triangles and sew them together to form squares. Each square should be made up of one yellow and one blue triangle.

Take the long strips of yellow fabric and join a square to each end, matching the colours to the strip. Refer to the main diagram to make sure that the square pieces are facing the right way. Add a 9¼" blue strip to each end to complete your left and right hand border pieces. Attach these to the centre panel of the quilt.

With the remaining pieces, complete the top and bottom border in the same way and attach these to the quilt.

This completes the top layer.

Sandwich together the top layer, wadding and backing and quilt using cross hatching designs with the lemon and dark blue thread.

Add binding to the quilt

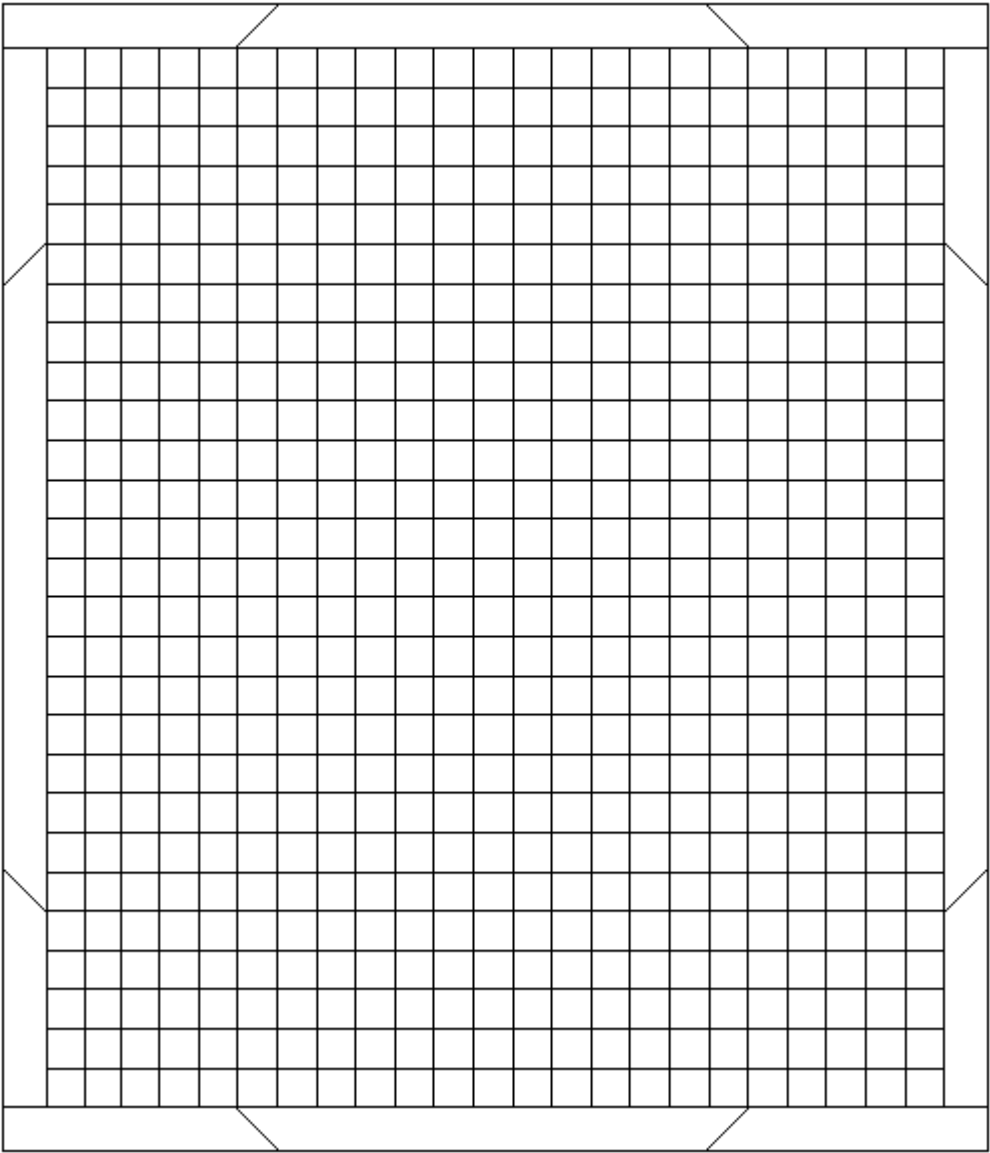
