Fabrics from Park Lane range of fabrics by Fabric Freedom.

Requirements

Fabric 1. Large blue squares F321 col.2 -	1 Row, 5 squares
Fabric 2. Beige tonal shadows F318 col.2 -	40cm.
Fabric 3. Blue leaves with white flowers F317 col.2 -	25cm.
Fabric 4. Dark beige ferns F319 col.2 -	25cm.
Fabric 5. White blossom with blue leaves F316 col.2 -	25cm.
Fabric 6. Blue and white grasses F320 col.2 -	25cm.
Fabric 7. Blue mottle from Misty range F1200 col.9 -	80cm.

Wadding and backing - 46" x 46"

Thread

Aurifil Mako.

1128 – blue

2310 – dark cream

2710 – light blue

Cutting

From Fabric 1.

5 x 7½" x 7½" squares - Block 1.

From Fabric 2.

10 x 2¼" x 9" pieces - Block 1.

10 x 2¼" x 12½" squares - Block 1.

4 x 2½" x 2½" squares - Corners of Borders.

From Fabric 3.

4 x 2½" x 2½" squares - Block 2.

8 x 2½" x 4½" pieces - Block 2.

4 x 2½" x 6½" pieces - Block 2.

1 x 3½" x 42" strip - Block 2.

From Fabric 4.

4 x 2½" x 2½" squares - Block 2.

8 x 2½" x 4½" pieces - Block 2.

4 x 2½" x 6½" pieces - Block 2.

1 x 3½" x 42" strip - Block 2.

From Fabric 5.

4 x 2½" x 2½" squares - Block 2.

8 x 2½" x 4½" pieces - Block 2.

4 x 2½" x 6½" pieces - Block 2.  
1 x 3½" x 42" strip - Block 2.

From Fabric 6.

4 x 2½" x 2½" squares - Block 2.  
8 x 2½" x 4½" pieces - Block 2.  
4 x 2½" x 6½" pieces - Block 2.  
1 x 3½" x 42" strip - Block 2.

From Fabric 7.

48 x 2½" x 2½" squares - Block 2.  
10 x 1¼" x 7½" pieces - Block 1.  
10 x 1¼" x 9" pieces - Block 1.  
5 x 1½" x 42" strips- Border.  
8 x 1½" x 2½" pieces- Border.

## Making up

### Block 1

Take two 1¼" x 7½" pieces of fabric 7, and attach to the left and right hand side of a square of fabric 1. Next take two 1¼" x 9" pieces of fabric 7, and attach them to the left and right hand side of the panel and press back.

Take two 2¼" x 9" pieces of fabric 2, and attach them to the opposite sides of the square, followed by adding a 2¼" x 12½" piece of fabric 2, to the remaining sides.

You will need to make 5 of these blocks in total.

### Block 2.

Lay out all of your pieces as per diagram (the numbers on the diagram indicate the fabric to use).

The block is made in 4 smaller parts.

Take the rectangular pieces that are towards the centre of the block and place a square of fabric 7 onto the end with right sides together and sew diagonally from corner to corner, you may wish to draw a pencil guideline to help you sew a straight line, take care in making sure that you are sewing across the right way. Cut ¼" away from the outside edge, then press back.

Again lay out all of your pieces for the block. And divide it into quarters, working on one quarter at a time.

Start by sewing the two square pieces together and press back, then join to the adjacent rectangle of the same size. Press.

Add the next rectangle to the end and press back.

Complete the quarter piece by adding the last long rectangular piece.

Repeat this for each of the quarters, and then sew them together.

Always refer to the diagram if you are unsure.

You will need to make 4 of these in total.

Lay out your blocks as shown in the main diagram and join them together in rows, then join the rows together pressing back as you go.

Take two strips of fabric 7 and join to either side of the sides of the blocks, press back and trim to size. Add a strip of fabric 7 to the top and bottom edges, press back and trim.

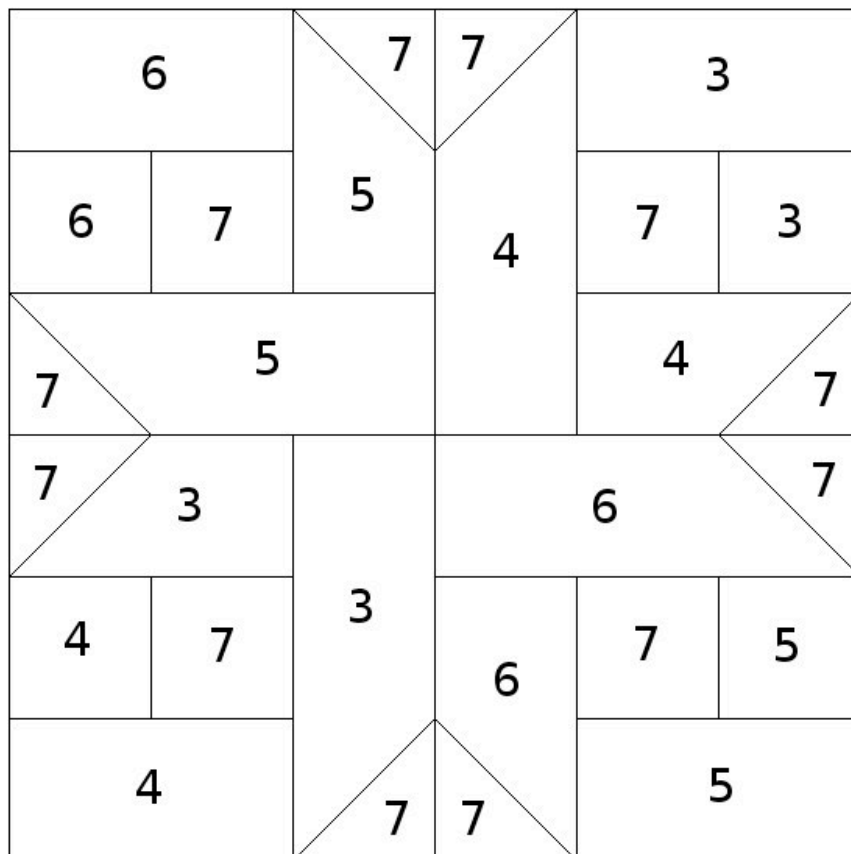
Take all of your 3½" x 42" strips and join them together along the long edge to form a wider strip. Cut this strip off at 2½" intervals. Join these new pieces together in blocks of 3, in order to form a long strip which is used for the border. Add a 1½" x 2½" piece of fabric 7 to each end of all of the border pieces.

Add a border to opposite sides of the centre panel.

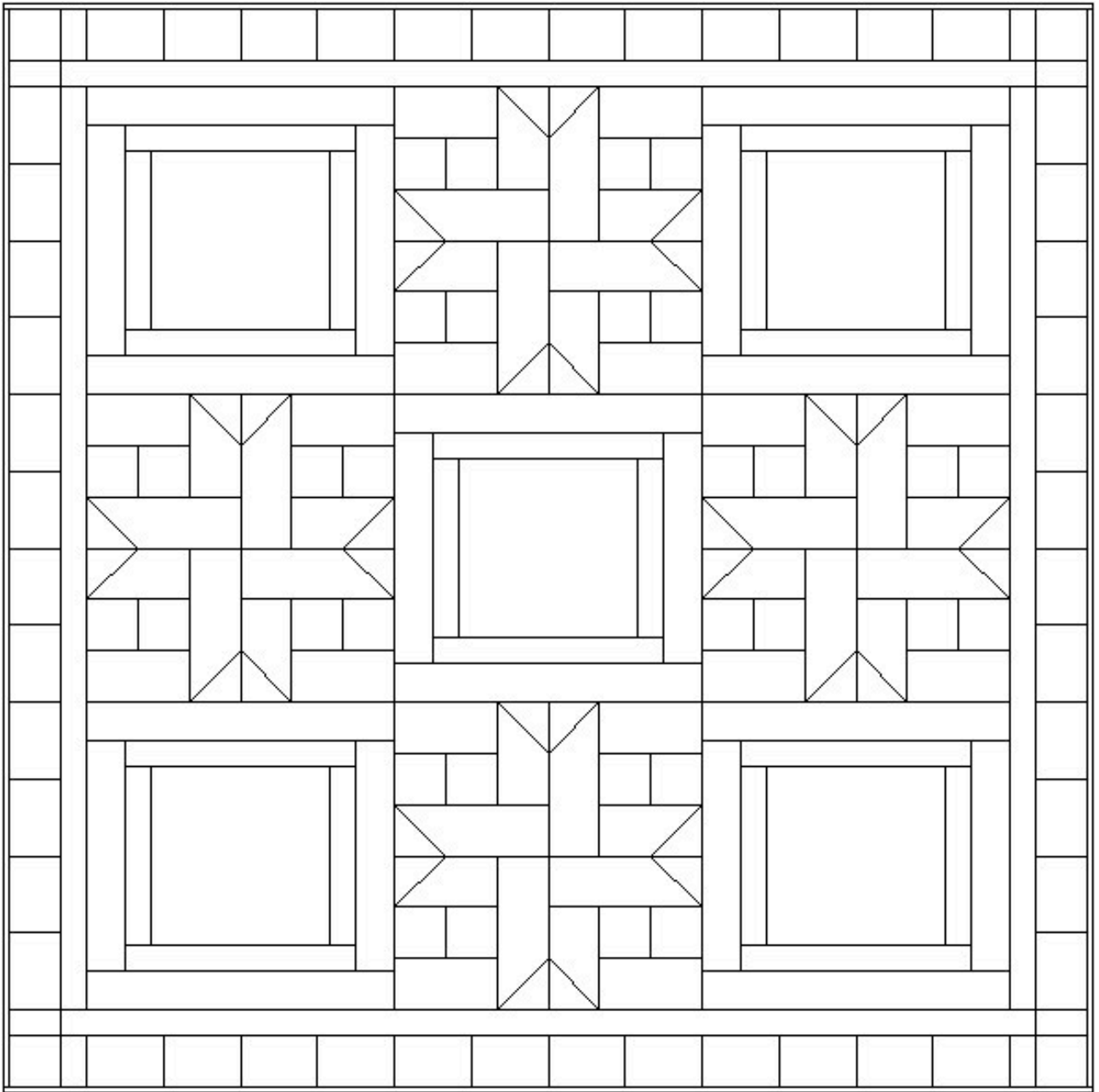
Take the two remaining border pieces, and join a 2½" square of fabric 2 to either end, then attach this border strip to the centre panel to complete the top layer.

Sandwich together top layer, wadding and backing and quilt with floral designs.

Add binding to the quilt made from fabric 7.
