Requirements.

White butterflies F411 col.1	-	Fat 1/8
Ivory butterflies F411 col.2	-	Fat 1/8
Blue butterflies F411 col.3	-	Fat 1/8
Pink butterflies F411 col.4	-	Long 1/4
White teddies F412 col.1	-	Fat 1/8
Ivory teddies F412 col.2	-	Fat 1/8
Blue teddies F412 col.3	-	Long 1/4
Pink teddies F412 col.4	-	Fat 1/8
White hearts F413 col.1	-	Fat 1/8
Ivory hearts F413 col.2	-	Fat 1/8
Blue hearts F413 col.3	-	Fat 1/8
Pink hearts F413 col.4	-	Fat 1/8
White rosebud F414 col.1	-	Fat 1/8
Ivory rosebud F414 col.2	-	Fat 1/8
Blue rosebud F414 col.3	-	Fat 1/8
Pink rosebud F414 col.4	-	Fat 1/8

Wadding and backing 35" x 42"

Thread

Mako Aurifil

2479 - pink

3660 - blue

2024 - white

Cutting.

Take your 16 fabric pieces, and pair them together Blue and white, Pink and Cream. From the pink and cream fabrics, cut 36 x 3⁷/₈" x 3⁷/₈" squares from each, that makes 72 squares in total.

From the blue and white fabric, cut 34 x 3⁷/₈" x 3⁷/₈" squares from each, that makes 68 in total.

Making up.

Take your blue and white squares and the pink and cream squares, place rights sides

together.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the light fabric.

With the fabric right sides together, sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on each side of the marked line.

Cut on the marked line, and press open.

Do this to all the squares.

You will end up with 140 in total.

From your squares, you will have the pieces to make 9 pin-wheels as in *diagram 1*.
5 pink and 4 blue.

You will also have 28 flying geese to make as in *diagram 2*.

14 pink and 14 blue.

When making up your flying geese blocks, 8 will have the pink at the top and the remaining 6 will have the blue at the top.

The third type of block is shown in *diagram 3*.

You will make 12 of these in total.

2 pink triangles and 2 blue triangles are used in each block.

When making up blocks the pink will point in and the blue will point out.

Press as you go

When you have made all of the blocks, lay them out as in the main diagram.

Sew them in rows and then join the rows together to complete the quilt.

Sandwich the quilt together quilt top, wadding and backing.

Quilt by hand or sewing machine.

Add the binding to the quilt, made from the pink and blue fabrics.

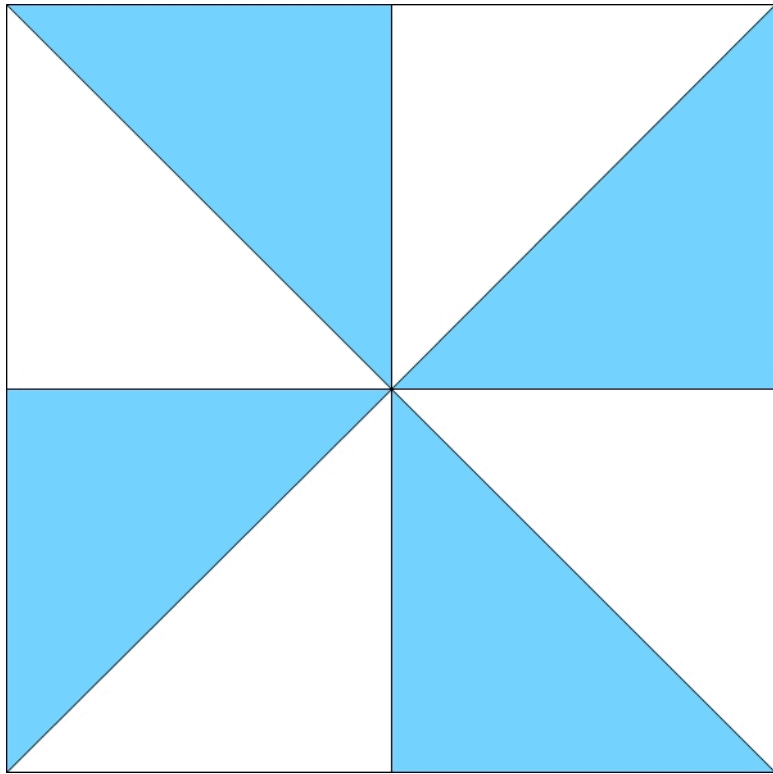
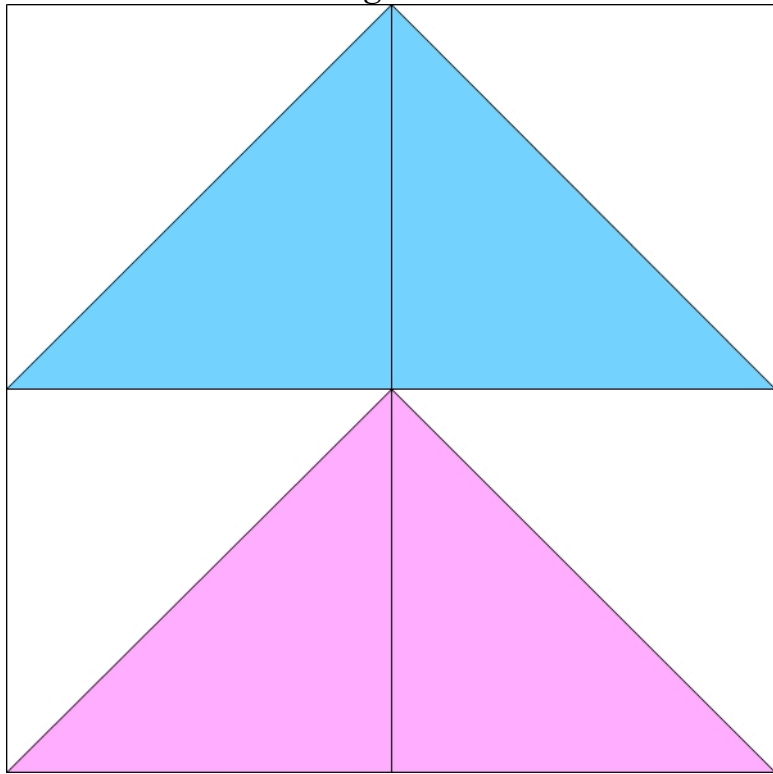


Diagram 1



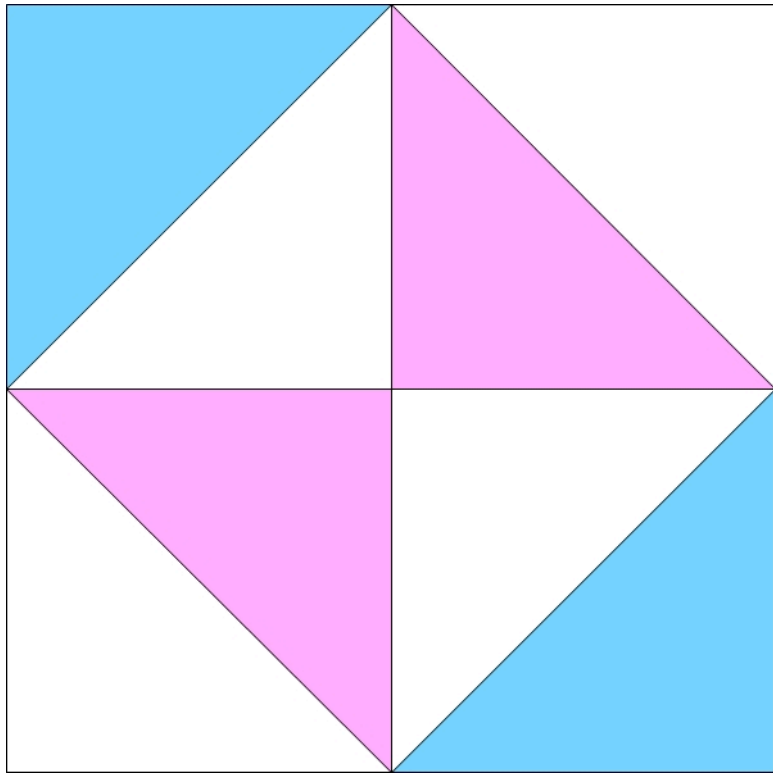
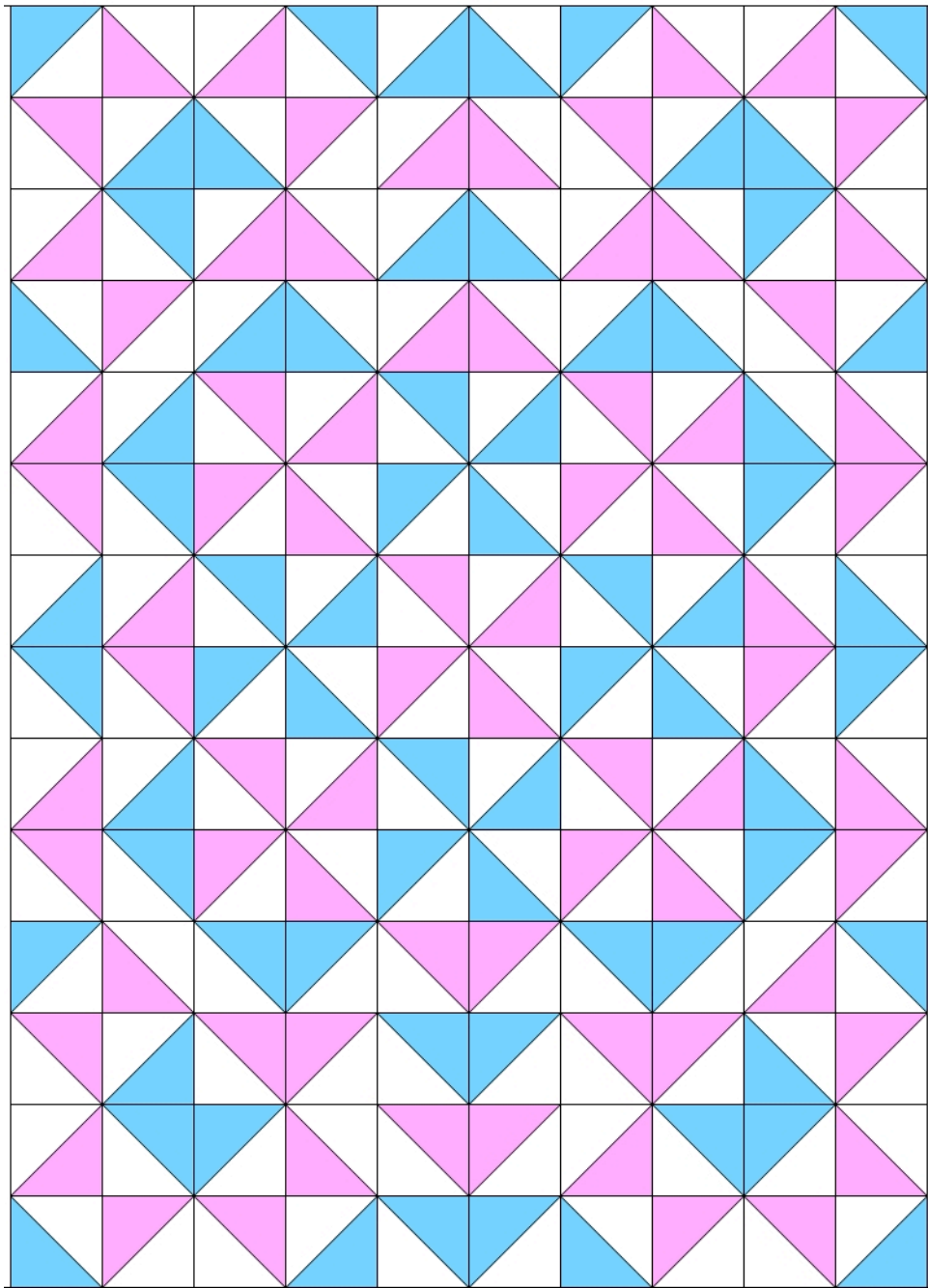
