

FabricFreedom Strawberry Delight

Two cushions – 18" x 18"

Made by Sally Ablett

Requirements

1. Large squares on cream F221 col 2 - 1 row
2. Strawberries on black F222 col 1 - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. Tonal cream leaves F226 col 1 - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
4. Cream strawberry stripe F227 col 2 - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. Small strawberry on black F223 col 2 - fat $\frac{1}{8}$

Wadding $\frac{1}{2}$ m

Backing 60cm (fabric 226-2)

Thread

Aurifil threadcount 40

2255 Red

Cutting

1. 4 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
2. 14 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, cut in half diagonally once
3. 2 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut in half diagonally twice
4 x $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $3\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangles
2 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, cut in half diagonally once
4. 4 x Template left
4 x Template right
5. 8 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, cut in half diagonally once
4 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Making

Lay out all of your fabric pieces, as shown in the diagram.

Sew the triangles of fabric 5, to the small triangles of fabric 3, to make the square corner pieces

Sew the small triangles of fabric 2, to the larger triangles of fabric 3, to form rectangles

Sew the small triangles of fabric 3 to the template pieces of fabric 4.

Sew the small triangles of fabric 2, to the opposite sides of the square of fabric 3 and press back. Sew the triangles of fabric 2 and 5 to the remaining sides and press back.

Again, lay out all of the pieces. Join the pieces together to make 4 rows, pressing back as you go. Then join these 4 rows together to complete the top layer.

Sandwich together the top layer and wadding, then quilt with designs mimicking the fabric patterns.

Make an envelope back, and attach it to the top layer, right sides together, before turning right sides out to complete the cushion.
