

# William Morris Cats.

Designed and made by Sally Ablett.  
Quilt Size 39" x 39".  
Block size 7" x 7"

All fabrics are from The William Morris Cats and William Morris Palette ranges by Fabric Freedom

## Requirements.

1 – All over cats with blue leaves F367 col. 3 -	Fat ¼
2 – Dark pink leaves F308 col. 28 -	Fat ¼
3 – Light pink leaves F308 col. 29 -	Fat ¼
4 – Cats with pink flowers F368 col. 3 -	Fat ¼
5 – Dark blue leaves F308 col. 12 -	Fat ¼
6 – Light blue leaves F308 col. 14 -	Fat ¼
7 – Mid blue leaves F308 col. 13 -	Fat ¼
8 – Pink and blue flowers and leaves F369 col. 3 -	Fat ¼
9 – Pink and blue cat squares F366 col. 3 -	2 rows
10 – Cream fabric -	½ yd ( 40 cms )

Wadding and backing - 43" x 43"

Thread Aurifil mako.  
2770 pale blue  
2021 cream.

## Cutting for Block one.

From fabric 1 – 8 x 4 ½" x 4 ½" squares

From fabric 2 – 32 x 2" x 4 ½" strips

From fabric 3 – 32 x 2" x 2" squares

## Cutting for Block two.

From fabric 4 – 8 x 4 ½" x 4 ½" squares

From fabric 5 – 32 x 2" x 4 ½" strips

From fabric 6 – 32 x 2" x 2" squares

## Cutting for sashing.

From fabric 7 – 64 x 2" x 2 ½" strips

From fabric 8 – 24 x 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips

16 x 2" x 2 ½" strips

From fabric 9 – 16 x 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares

From fabric 10 – 48 x 1" x 7 ½" strips

32 x 1" x 3 ½" strips

## Making up.

Lay out your fabric pieces for Block 1 and Block 2.

Sew the pieces together in rows pressing back as you go.

Now sew the rows together to complete the block.

In total you will need 8 of Block one, and 8 of Block two.

It's advised that you read through the next section carefully, as some of your blocks are going to stay whole, while others are going to be cut into smaller sections.

### Block 1

From block one you keep 5 whole blocks.

From one of the blocks you will need to cut a 3½" square from each corner

From one of the blocks you should cut a 3½" x 7½" strip from either side.

From the remaining block you will need to cut a 3½" x 7½" strip from the top and bottom of the block.

### Block 2

From block two you keep 4 whole blocks.

From two of the blocks you should cut a 3½" x 7½" strip from either side.

From the remaining two blocks you will need to cut a 3½" x 7½" strip from the top and bottom of the block.

### Sashing

Take a piece of fabric 8, 2½" x 4½" and add a piece of fabric 7 to each end.

Now a piece of fabric 8, 2" x 2½" and add a piece of fabric 7 to one end.

Do this to all of your pieces of fabrics 8 and 7.

Next add your cream strips to the two sides of all the pieces, pressing as you go.

Now lay out all of the blocks with sashing in between.

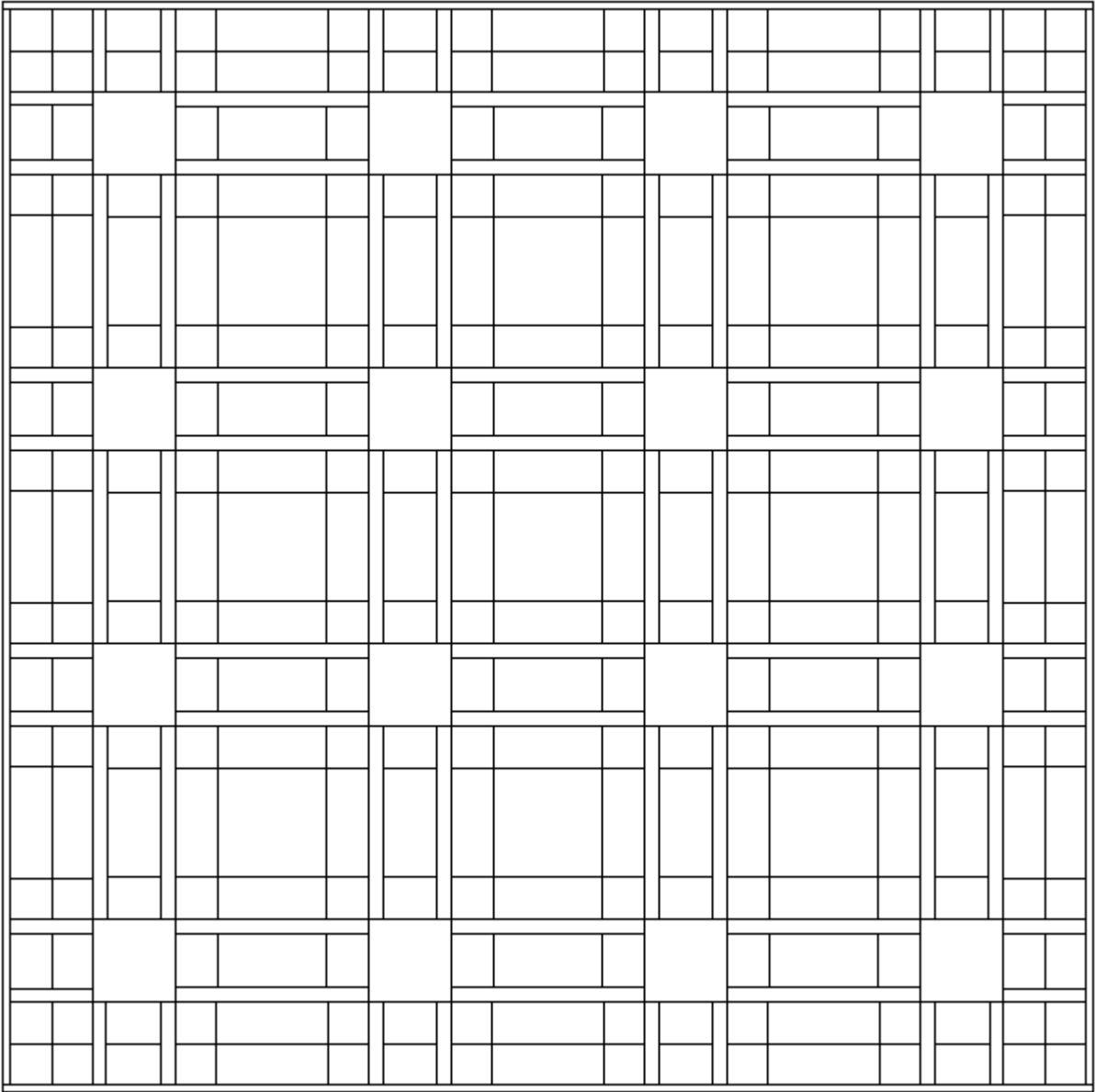
Sew the pieces together in rows and press.

Next sew the rows together to complete the quilt top.

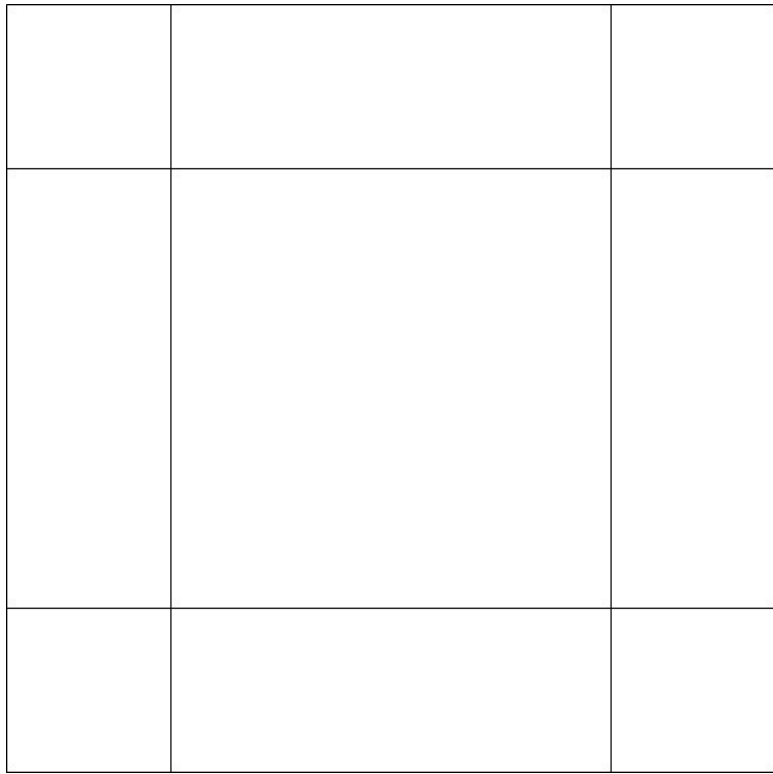
Sandwich together the top layer, wadding and backing.

Machine or hand quilt.

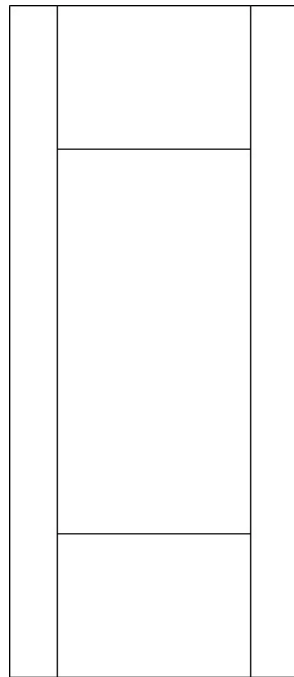
Attach binding made from left over fabric pieces to complete the quilt.
