| 11. Irregular white spot on red F525 col.27 | - | long¼ | (binding) |

Wadding and backing 51"x 51" (Warm & Natural)

Thread Aurifil

4668 red/cream

4664 black/grey

Cutting

For block 1

From fabric 1 cut

7 x 7½"x 7½" cut in half diagonally once

From fabric 2 cut

13 x 2⅛" x 9⅛"

13 x 2⅛" x 10⅞"

From fabric 3 cut

7 x 4⅛" x 4⅛" cut in half diagonally once

From fabric 4 cut

13 x 1⅜" x 5"

13 x 1⅜" x 5⅞"

From fabric 5 cut

13 x 1¾" x 7⅛"

13 x 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 8 $\frac{3}{8}$ "
From fabric 6 cut
13 x 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 9 $\frac{5}{8}$ "
13 x 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 10 $\frac{7}{8}$ "

For block 2

From fabric 7 cut
4 x 5" x 5" cut in half diagonally once
From fabric 8 cut
8 x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 11 $\frac{3}{4}$ "
From fabric 9 cut
8 x 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 15 $\frac{3}{8}$ "

For block 3

From fabric 8 cut
4 x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{8}$ "
From fabric 9 cut
1 x 5 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{3}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally twice
4 x 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 7 $\frac{7}{8}$ "

Border

From fabric 10 cut
5 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42"

Making up

Block 1

- Lay out all of the fabrics as shown in the diagram.
- The block is made up of two large triangles. To make the first triangle take fabric 1 and sew on the short strip of fabric 2, as in the diagram. Press and attach the longer strip of fabric 2. Trim the ends in line with the long edge.
- Make the other triangle in the same way using fabrics 3, 4, 5 and 6.
- Join the two halves of the block together and press.
- Make another twelve blocks.

Block 2

- Lay out all of the fabrics as shown in the diagram.
- Take fabric 7 and sew to fabric 8, trim corners to size. Attach fabric 9 and press and trim as before
- Make another seven blocks.

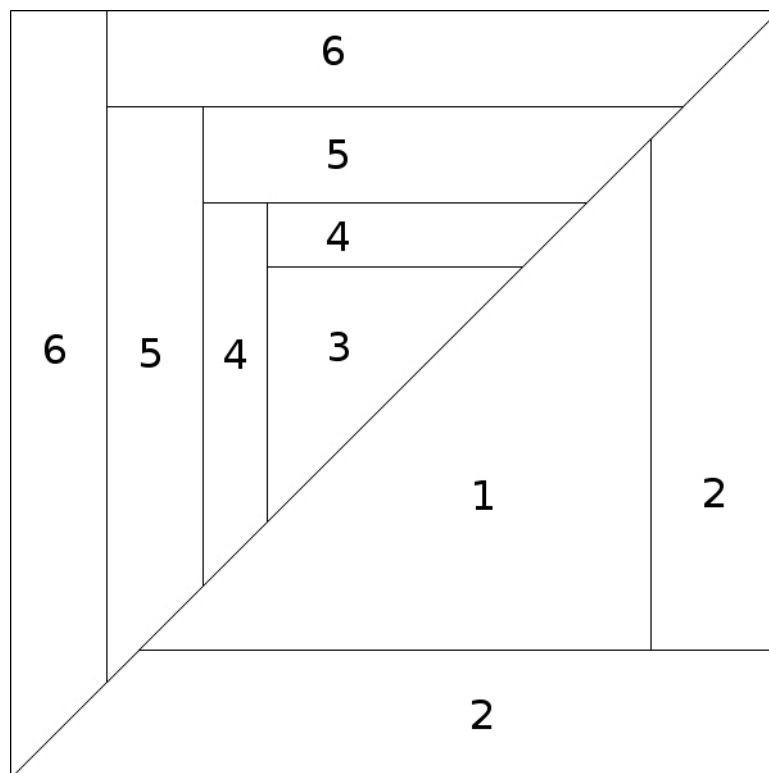
Block 3

- Lay out all of the fabrics as shown in the diagram.
- Sew fabric 9 to fabric 8, press and trim and finally attach fabric 9, again press and trim.
- Make another three blocks.

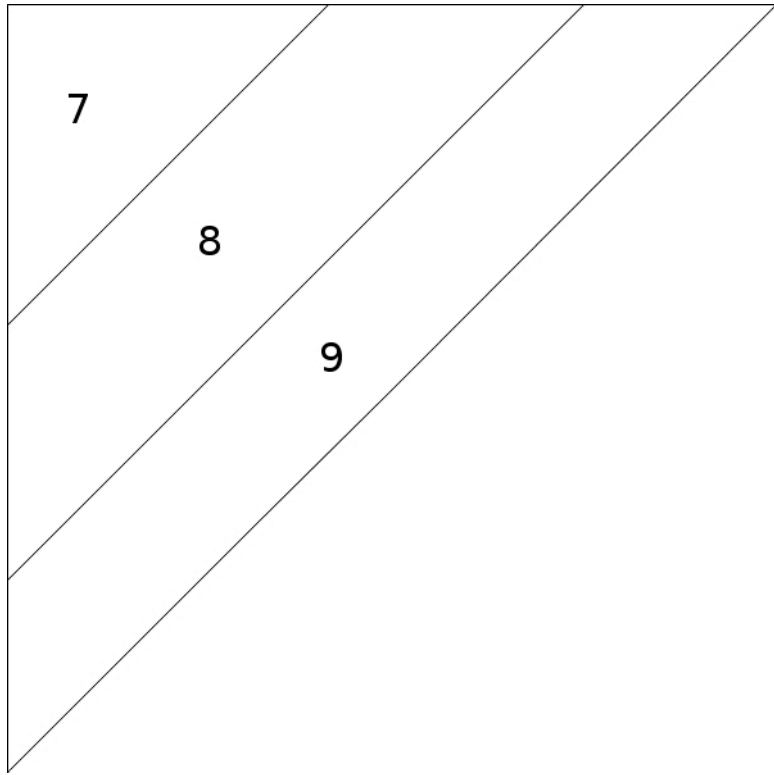
Assembling the quilt

- Lay out all of the blocks as shown in the main diagram.

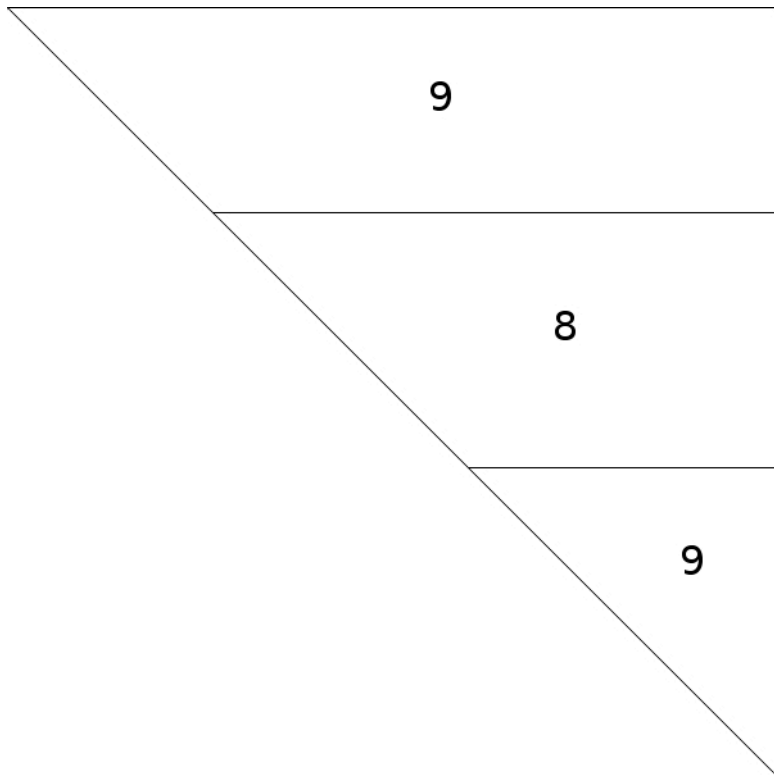
- Sew the blocks together in diagonal rows, adding the black sashing strips between each block as you sew.
- Press each row as you complete it.
- Join the rows together, again sewing the sashing strips between each row.
- Add the border strips, you will need to join strips to make a long enough piece. Sew the sides first and then the top and bottom
- Sandwich together the top wadding and backing fabric and quilt by hand or machine.
- Add binding using fabric 11.



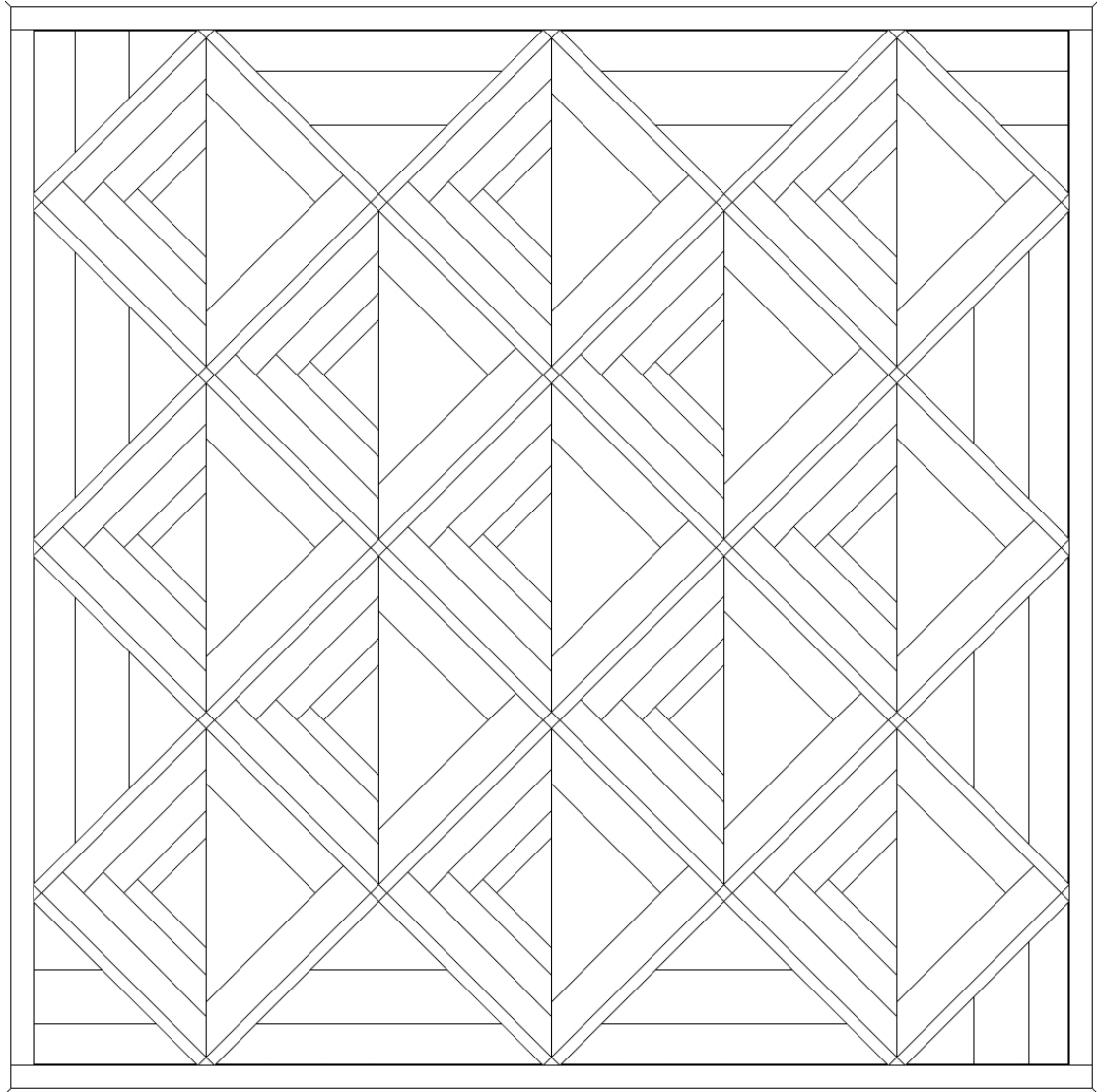
